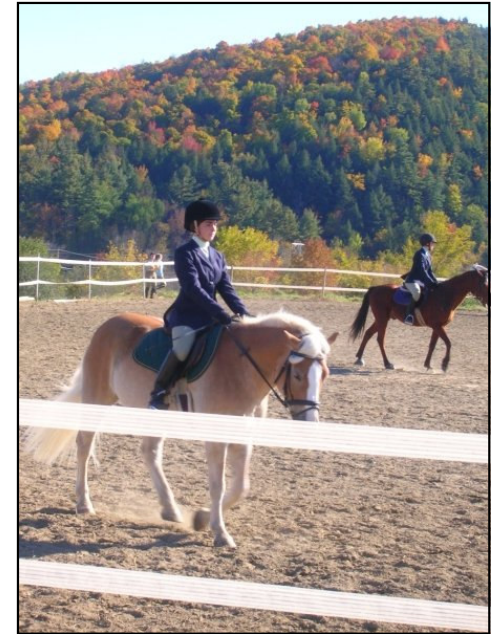

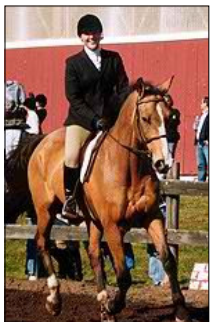

The UVM Equestrian Team is one of the most successful in the country. Regardless of your level of expertise, you will find that riding on the team will give you access to an unparalleled riding education. Inter-collegiate competi-

tion offers unique challenges to accomplished riders, and expert instruction is offered from beginner through advanced levels. The program's focus is hunter seat equitation and basic dressage, involving 35 students each semester. Tryouts are held at the beginning of each year, with interim tryouts held at the beginning of the winter term to fill any open slots.
